Vaccine maker backed by Bill &

New York (CNN Business) – CureVac, a German biotech working on a Covid-19 vaccine that is backed by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation and has a manufacturing agreement with Elon Mus**T**esla (TSLA), soared again Monday aftermore than tripling its Wall Street debut Friday.

Shares of <u>CureVac</u> were up about 40% Monday after its CEO Franz-Werner Haa<u>said in an interview</u> with the German financial news site Boerse Online over the weekend that he was hopeful its vaccine will be approved regulators early next year. Haas added that an "accelerated approval was possible" as we

CureVac recently received approval from the governments of Germany and Belgium to stellinical trialsfor one of its vaccines for Covid-19.


CureVac is also backed by billionaire Dietmar Hopp, the co-founder of German software gi&AP (SAP).



Hopp owns nearly half of CureVac. The German government and Big Pharma leadeGlaxoSmithKline (GSK)also have big stakes in the company. The Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation invested \$40 million in CureVac in 2015.

CureVac has a development and intellectual property agreement with Tesla since November 2015, according regulatory filingswith the Securities and Exchange Commission.
